VICAR'S LETTER

Dear Friends,

As I write snowdrops are proudly bursting forth in the vicarage garden. We are gradually entering the lengthening of days where the world escapes the darkness of winter and enters the new light of spring. We are also entering the season of Lent and Easter.

Lent and Easter, for me, is a recognition of the same escape from darkness in to light. Jesus' death on the cross brought a sense of dark foreboding to the world, where, according to the scriptures there was a masking of the Sun and a literal darkness came over the world. This darkness was of course replaced three days later with the greatest event in human history, the bodily resurrection from the dead of the Saviour. Jesus rose again. Light came out of darkness.
